

The Home's History

The original Medina County Home was built in 1854 to provide housing for indigent persons who were unable to care for themselves. A fire destroyed the original building and it was rebuilt in 1861. This main building is still in use today, and several additions have been constructed.

For many years, the County Home was a working farm. Proceeds from farming operations helped offset the cost of running the facility. In 1970 the Medina County Board of Commissioners decided to discontinue farming and raising livestock. The remaining acreage is currently leased for farming. Renovations, improvements and remodeling have continued throughout the years.

The Home today is situated on approximately 10 acres and is a 51 bed facility which provides primary custodial, rest-home-type care. It operates much like a licensed, private rest home, but is not Medicare/Medicaid funded. The Home maintains all requirements according to state fire and safety codes.

A continuing commitment by the residents of Medina County is evident in the continual passing of a 0.275 mills levy to support the Home. THANK YOU!!

Adult Day Care Services are also available. This service provides a comfortable setting and socialization for adults. This also allows caregivers "Time off" from care giving responsibilities.
